The HHS' Office of Inspector General imposes compliance obligations on health care providers as part of its settlements of Federal health care program investigations arising under a variety of false claims statutes. These provider compliance obligations, following a federal investigation, often take the form of a Corporate Integrity Agreement (CIA) which is executed between the provider and the OIG.

Under a CIA, the provider consents to certain obligations as part of the civil settlement and/or in exchanged for the Office of Inspector General's agreement not to exclude that health care provider from participation in Medicare, Medicaid and other Federal health care programs. Generally, providers who settle these cases do not admit that they were liable or that they committed the alleged conduct.

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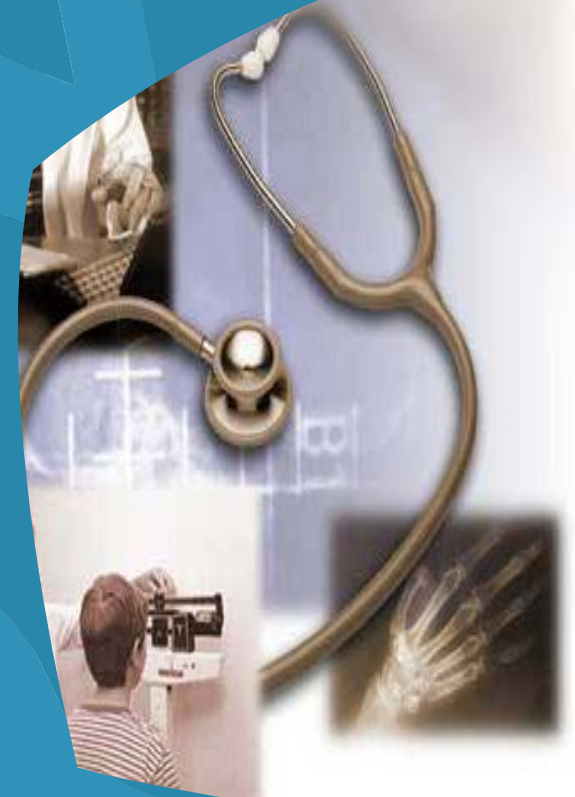
